- PLAINTIFFS' OBJECTION TO DISCOVERY COMMISSIONER'S REPORT AND RECOMMENDATIONS: Arguments by Counsel. Colloquy regarding subpoena's and modifying subpoena's. Upon Court's inquiry, Mr. Segal noted he could produce bank records of Hahn's World Of Surplus Inc. COURT stated its findings and ORDERED, Objection to Discovery Commissioner's Report, is Overruled In Part. Court directed Mr. Segal to produce the bank records of Hahn's World of Surplus Inc. and Ms. Taylor will need to renotice subpoena's to the bank within 30 days. COURT FURTHER ORDERED, as to the individual records, DENIED. Upon Mr. Segal's inquiry, Court Ordered the payroll accounting be produced. Counsel stipulated to a confidentiality order.

PLAINTIFFS' MOTION TO EXTEND EXPERT DISCLOSURE AND DISCOVERY DEADLINES; EXPARTE APPLICATION FOR AN ORDER SHORTENING TIME THEREON (SECOND REQUEST): Arguments by Counsel. COURT ORDERED, When Ms. Taylor receives the documents, Court will allow 3 weeks for the expert report and if there is a discovery dispute, the Expert report will be required to be submitted and Counsel may file a motion to compel. Court noted its concerns, and noted discovery should not wait for one year. Court reminded Counsel, discovery issue are to be heard in this Department.
