I.

FINDINGS

Motion to Quash Subpoenas filed by Defendants Larry Hahn ("HAHN") and Hahn's World of Surplus, Inc.'s ("SURPLUS")(HAHN and SURPLUS sometimes collectively referred to herein as ("HAHN DEFENDANTS") and Nominal Defendant Kokoweef, Inc. and Defendant Patrick C. IT IS FURTHER RECOMMENDED that Plaintiffs not review, copy, inspect or otherwise view the records obtained relating to the HAHN DEFENDANTS:

IT IS FURTHER RECOMMENDED that all documents obtained by Plaintiffs through the improperly issued subpoenas be delivered to the HAHN DEFENDANTS immediately;
