

# NEW MAGNETOMETER SURVEYS SHOW THE BEST PLACES TO Drill, Drill, Drill!!!

#### TEN DRILLS!

Jim Hanhardt brokered an excellent deal for 3 more diamond drills, with accessories, from the Homestake Mine in South Dakota. The hard part came when he and Wayne Haskell muscled them on and off elevators from 6,800 feet below the surface! Thanks men! What a way to spend your time off!

At first, thoughts centered around diamond drilling at the east end of the basecamp. However, discussions with Mr. Hewitt quickly led us to realize only very limited information was available for the 5 acre site. So, rather than drilling for the love of drilling, just to "get lucky", we

opted to do more electronic surveys to find the absolute BEST LOCATION under the basecamp. As luck would have it, Mr. Hewitt had his new magnetometer. He wanted to test how well it would detect four KNOWN caves on Kokoweef with different sizes, shape and depth. The results were outstanding! Geo-Western's magnetometer precisely located all four known caverns with the largest readings (negative-numbers) directly over the center of each cave! GO! GO! GO!

These results led us into a flurry of unscheduled magnetometer surveys over "hot spots" of the previous electronic surveys. Many electronic targets were re-confirmed as likely, but unknown, caverns. One high-resistance (electronic) target was scientifically eliminated as being mineral and not cavernous. This knowledge keeps us from losing precious time, money and volunteer effort while we go directly for the real ones.

### WHAT'S NEXT?

This recent turn of events does not shift our attention from the major indication for deep caverns featured at last year's picnic. The ongoing diamond drilling projects, Triangle Map area and the Rusty Red Hole will remain focused toward that same goal. In fact, magnetometry strongly indicated the electronic targets at the higher elevations on Kokoweef are probably caverns rather than impassable, high-resistance minerals. That's encouraging .... but there's more !!!

#### CATHY'S CAVE

Another electronic target was re-affirmed and then upgraded in status using magnetometry. Surveys show two long, linear patterns mapped over 2,300 feet from Cathy's Cave to the basecamp! Just below Cathy's Cave (see next page), the main, hidden cavern potential appears to be larger, deeper and longer than the

known Kokoweef Cave! If we physically prove it's exists through diamond drilling and video camera probes, then it's worth the expense and effort of tunneling. Next, the descent team could inspect if passages go safely down under the basecamp. If so, a laser survey by Jim Hanhardt would guarantee success for the first drill hole at the basecamp!

Back in 1940, (59 years ago) there may have been many good reasons Earl Dorr proposed starting a tunnel to go under Kokoweef Cave which is very near what is now Cathy's Cave. But it was never started.

We know Cathy's Cave has measureable air flow. We also know, from past well drilling at basecamp, that 1200 c.f.m. of air was pumped and lost down a crack, over 250 feet below the surface. It didn't build up a bit of back pressure in over 5 minutes!

We believe the magnetometer mapping reveals two cavern tubes linking these two locations. If so, it may be the gradual passage, leading down and under the base camp, to the deep and hidden underground canyon and Earl Dorr's legendary "River-of-Gold."




## WHERE'S CRYSTAL CAVE'S PASSAGEWAY ?






## DIAMOND DRILLING WILL FIND THE FACTS!


WHAT"S NEXT?
